

## ***Pseudechis guttatus* Envenomation Photographs**

Photographic series shows the progression and subsequent resolution of local tissue injury following envenomation by juvenile spotted black snake *Pseudechis guttatus*.

Injury was surgically debrided 104 hours post-envenomation.

Photographic series covers period from 24 hours envenomation to 120 hours post-debridement (224 hours post envenomation).


