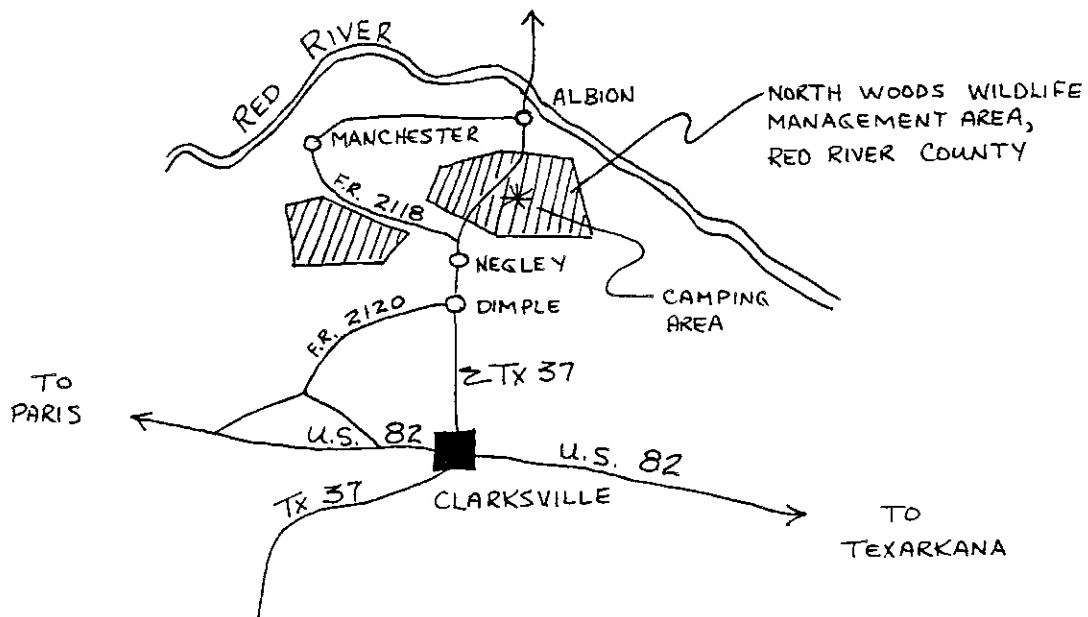

THS SPRING FIELD TRIP:

International Paper Company has granted permission to the THS for holding the spring meet on their North Woods Wildlife Management Area. The area consists of 25,000 acres and should be sufficient for our needs. The management area is located 12 miles north of Clarksville, Red River County on Texas 37 and Farm Road 2118. Follow the THS signs to our camping area. We were asked to camp as a group.

There are two areas to collect. One is flat with a mixture of pine and hardwood. There is water standing in this area with small islands of higher ground. The other area is much higher and has large clear cut areas. The forest rangers said the flat areas are best for collecting, which would be expected.

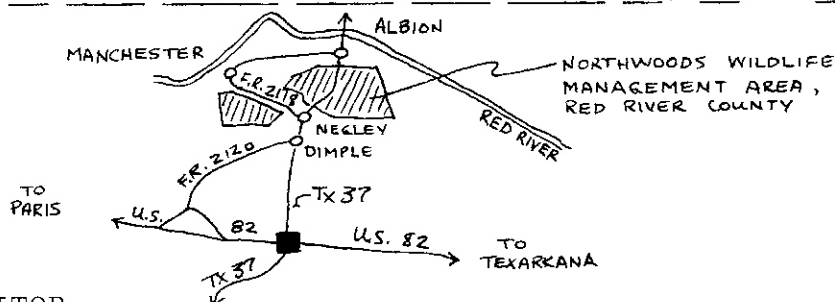
There are few restrictions this year on the collection of animals. Only those animals protected by law may not be collected. It is still a good practice to release all specimens not needed. Also, try to leave the habitat as you found it.

Things to bring: Seine; Marsh areas, ponds, creeks, and roadside ditches to be seined. Mosquito Repellent; Lots of water and lots of mosquitoes. Clear containers; For showing off your specimens collected. Information; For all the bull sessions. Camera; For all those memories of people and specimens collected.

We will supply: Maps of collecting areas. Check list of all possible specimens found on area. Pointers on where to go and what to look for.
